FY 2015-2016 U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development

The City of Compton expects to receive FY 2015-2016 United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) grant funds, including Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG). The City of Compton is authorized by HUD to distribute these funds to promote housing and community development for low- and moderate-income persons.

Who can apply?

- Organizations classified by the Internal Revenue Service as tax-exempt 501(c)(3);
- Organizations that have been in existence for at least two consecutive years;
- Projects that meet a HUD national objective and address a priority need identified by the City of Compton Consolidated Plan.
- Organizations that have matching funds from other sources.

To obtain an application: Applications will be available starting Wednesday, November 19, 2014 on the City's website at www.comptoncity.org. Note: The application will be in pdf format.

Applications must be submitted by **5:00 pm, Thursday, December 18, 2014** to the **Office of the City Clerk**, City of Compton, 205 S. Willowbrook Ave., Compton, CA 90220. Postmarks, facsimiles, e-mails, and late applications will not be accepted. Remember to get a receipt for your application!! Incomplete applications will not be allowed re-submittal.
