

NOTICE OF MEETING OF THE
OVERSIGHT BOARD OF THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO THE FORMER
COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY
OF THE CITY OF COMPTON

Notice is hereby given that the Oversight Board of the Successor Agency to the former Community Redevelopment Agency of the City of Compton will hold a meeting in the City Council Chambers located inside City Hall, 205 South Willowbrook Avenue, Compton, California, on June 8, 2016, at 10:00 AM to consider adopting a resolution directing the Successor Agency to convey to the City of Compton (“City”) three properties for governmental use. The three properties include:

- (i) The Martin Luther King Jr. Transit Center located at 310 N. Willowbrook Avenue in the City, an approximately 10,000 square foot multi-modal facility that serves the MTA Regional Bus Transit System and includes local layover facilities;
- (ii) The Dollarhide Community Center located at 301 N. Tamarind Avenue in the City, an approximately 30,000 square foot facility that includes assembly rooms, family rooms, a kitchen, and a community meeting room; and
- (iii) The three-story parking structure located at 301 N. Tamarind Avenue in the City, built to support the Transit Center and Community Center.
